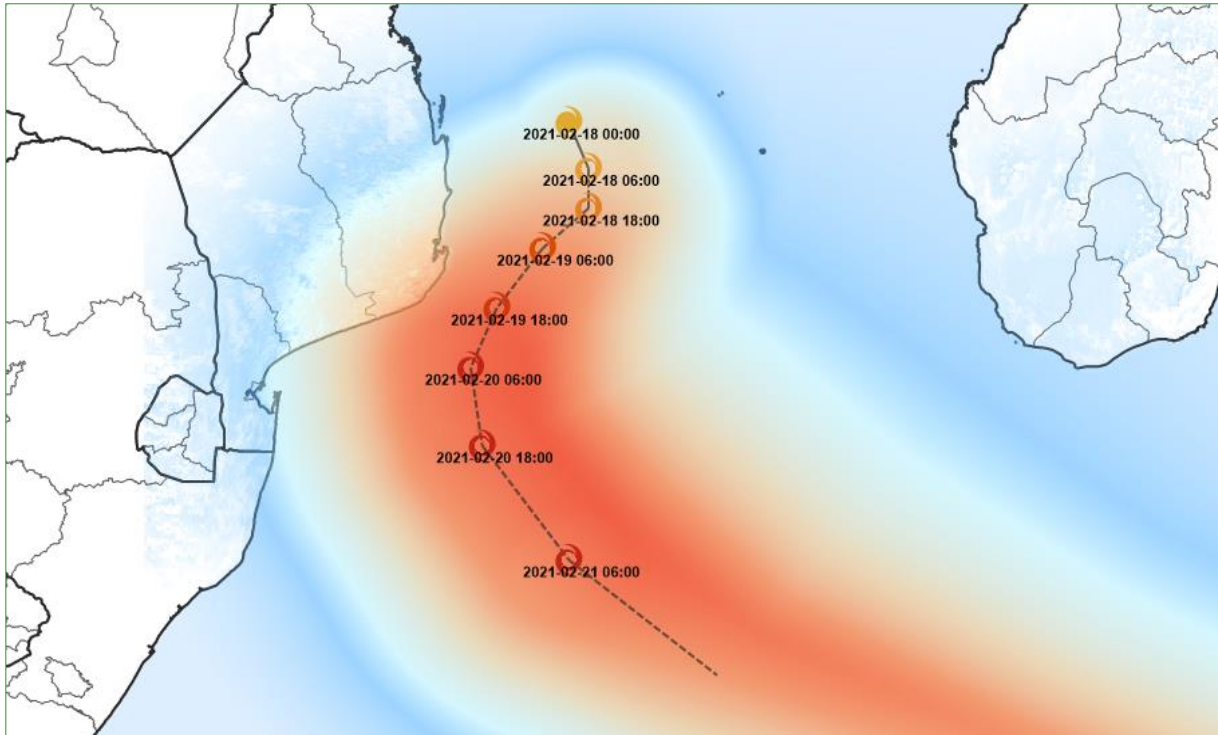


- The **moderate tropical storm GUAMBE** continues to evolve slowly about 250 km from the nearest Mozambican coast, but it could approach the Mozambican coast (Inhambane region) as early as Friday.
- This system should gradually intensify to become a tropical cyclone at the start of the weekend. Impacts in terms of high winds and heavy rains are expected in parts of southern Mozambique by Sunday.

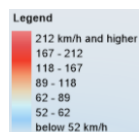

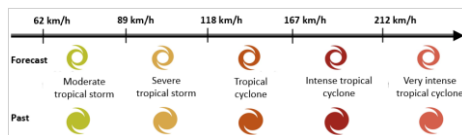
