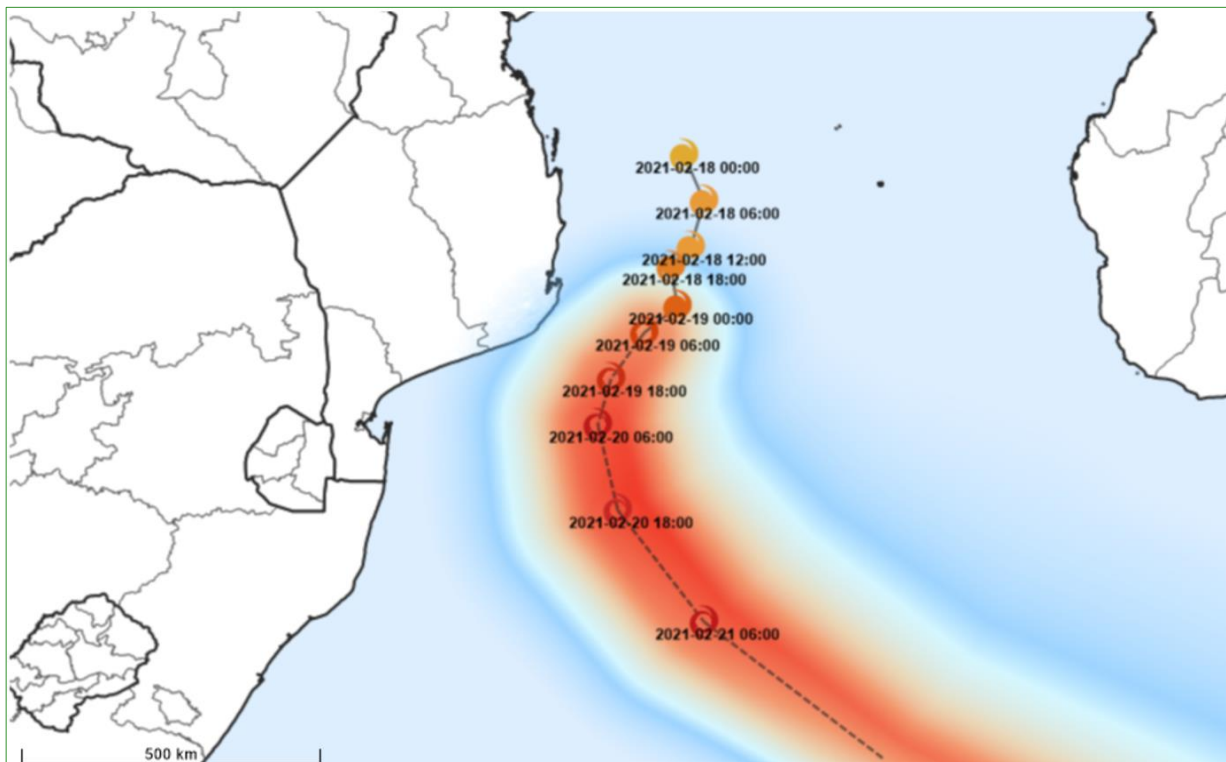
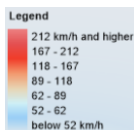

- **A landfall in Mozambique is now almost excluded**. The heart of the cyclone is expected to remain at a distance of at least 100 km from the Mozambican coast.

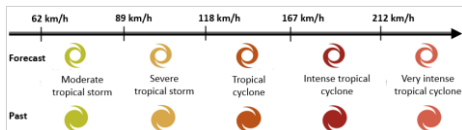

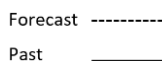
Wind speed
